
Survey sent to 109 Kosciusko County non-profit leaders

Framework

- Steering committee will provide oversight and leadership
- Initiate times for non-profits to meet which will allow them to collaborate and capitalize on what others are doing well; essentially strengthening each other through the sharing of ideas
- Sessions will include blend of time for networking, sharing ideas and structured training/workshops
