# Statistics

#### National

- 1 in 5 teens nation-wide abuses prescription drugs
- Nearly ½ of young people who inject heroin start by abusing prescription drugs
- 2 typical ways teens begin abusing prescription drugs
  - Out of curiosity or to alter the way they feel
  - Legitimate use of a prescription that turns to dependence


#### Our Region

Monthly drug usage in the North Central Indiana Region
(9 counties)

- 4,900 Seniors admit smoking pot 40 or more times per month
- 700 students admit using Cocaine 40 or more times per month
- 475 students admit using Heroin and/or Meth 40 or more times per month

#### Kosciusko County

 Years 2008-2012 and 2014 Kosciusko County was in the top 10 list of number of meth lab busts in Indiana



• 60-70% of the fatalities in Kosciusko county are alcohol or drug related
