

Whitko	45.1%	24%


+ Problem-continued

- There is currently no one single person or resource responsible for connecting school-aged children in Kosciusko County and their families with identified needs for social services
- Similar concerns identified in previous White Papers
- While United Way 211 has a purpose-considered "invasive" and "impersonal" making people hesitant to utilize





How do we provide one source that bridges the gap to connect needs and services?






Create a Grant funded position – placing one person as the liasion to connect identified needs with available services:

> <u>'Kosciusko KIDS (Kids In neeD</u> of Support and Services)

What does this position look like?

- After a period of planning and strategizing, someone that will:
 - Create and maintain a database of available services
 - Maintain an updated network of providers for available services
 - Work to establish resources that are identified as a need but not currently available in the county
 - Become heavily integrated and involved in the community, taking the program and referral process out to the public




What does this position look like (continued)?

- Someone that activates needed services through:
 - Public education
 - Schools and school websites, orientation days for staff and students
 - Churches
 - Public Forums and Fairs



+ Evolving Position

- As needs change, the Coordinator should stay current and ready to provide for the needs
- Coordinator will constantly assess and reassess available services vs needs
- Coordinator will maintain a current database/network
- Coordinator will identify gaps in services
- Coordinator will work to secure individuals, corporations, groups to fill needs
- Coordinator will be willing to use resources and imagination to create needed services
