Merriam Webster Dictionary defines bereavement as "the state or fact of being bereaved or deprived of something or someone.

Results of bereavement:

- Emotional Distress and anguish
- Sad, worried, scared, confused, angry, cheated, relieved, guilty
- > Ability to think and function in everyday life

Grief is defined as a "deep and poignant distress caused by or as if by bereavement."

Grief impacts people in a variety of different ways:

- Ability to sleep well
- > Eat well
- Concentrate and enjoy life in general.

Grief is not something that needs to be managed in isolation or by individualistic suffering.

Grief counseling can be a very difficult undertaking. Even after seminary training, pastors find themselves feeling under prepared and not being able to say the right words. This is not to say that Pastoral/Faith based counsel is not good and valid. It is saying however, that there are some complexities of the grief stages that a trained/licensed counselor is better equipped to deal with.
