Goals

- Work with Special Needs students to give them a sense of belonging and ability to give back to the community.
- Build partnerships within the community to provide a sustainable program.

Expected Results



- Fewer Student will receive discipline referrals in the elementary schools
- Elementary students will have better Attendance on Fridays and Mondays
- High School students will build a sense of responsibility towards each other and community



Process



- Letters were sent to parents of students on the free lunch program inviting them to participate.
- Applicants were reviewed by admin and staff.
- Student interns have started work towards grant writing and organizing the program.
- Backpacks were donated from a local business.
- Food was ordered for the first five weeks of the program.
- Food will be warehoused in the Mild/Moderate room at TVHS.
- Deliveries will begin on March 19th to Akron and Mentone Elementary Schools.
- Elementary students participating in the program will bring the backpacks back on Mondays.
- Interns will inventory the bags, inventory food, order food, and supervise packing.
